General Information:

- Review S&E eligibility requirements and rules in the MSBOA Yearbook before entering the students. If there are questions, please call one of us.
- All S&E applications must be received by the respective deadline dates listed above. Please review MSBOA policies regarding deadlines and late fees. There is a 24-hour grace period (e.g. if due on Friday, it must be postmarked by Saturday). There is a \$25.00 per event (maximum \$100) late fee. *The State Deadline is not as forgiving as we are.
- Send ONE check payable to: Treasurer, MSBOA District 6.
- Your school principal **MUST** sign your online entry invoice.
- When entering students for S&E, make sure you send:
 - The original online entry invoice with both director and principal signatures.
 - TWO copies of the online entry invoice.
 - Check payable to: Treasurer, MSBOA District 6.
- You will be required to work at least one shift at each festival in which you enter students.
- Provisions may be made for a Friday night performance at the HS S&E festival for events with SCHOOL CONFLICTS. A note of explanation is required for these students.
- Please enter a name as an accompanist when you register online. Use your name if you don't know who your accompanist will be at the time of registration. This will keep the system from scheduling events on top of each other with the same accompanist listed.
- Ensembles with participants from multiple schools must have a letter from each principal and band director of the non-registering school. They must present this letter on the day of the festival.
